


Figure 2: Results for domain name voting




Figure 3: Structure of the project website




Figure 4: Slider - Image 1




Figure 5: Slider - Image 2






Figure 6: Slider - Image 3




Figure 11: Additional home page screenshot - 3

The project finds its framework under the topic "Social Sciences and Humanities (SSH) aspects of the Clean- Energy Transition" and call: LC-SC3-CC-1-2018-2019-2020.

The project aims at developing a theoretically-based and empirically-grounded understanding of crosscutting issues related to SSH aspects (e.g.

socioeconomic, socio-technical, socio-ecological, socio-cultural, sociopolitical and socio-psychological, and gender related aspects) of Clean Energy Transition in European coal and carbon-intensive regions, so as to formulate a set of recommendations able to tackle these issues.




Figure 14: Work Plan sub-menu




Figure 15: Consortium Map




Figure 16: Consortium logos




Figure 18: Case Studies menu




Figure 19: Silesia case study - description page




Figure 20: Brindisi case study - description page





Figure 23: News and Events - Clippings





Figure 24: Outcomes - Dissemination Material








Chapter 8 - CONTACT Menu




Figure 25: Contact page

The website includes a dedicated Contact menu to facilitate effective communication. In addition to the details of the project coordinator, the Contact menu presents a Contact Form (Figure 25).
